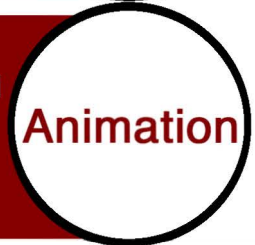

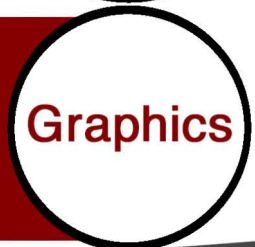
Students will understand concepts used to create digital audio using Adobe Audition, Garageband



Students will understand concepts used to create digital animations using Adobe Flash, Adobe Edge Animate, and Adobe After Effects



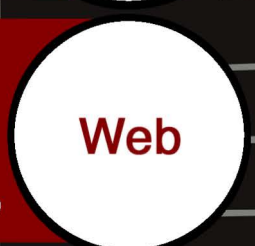
Students will understand concepts used to create digital graphics using Adobe Photoshop, Adobe InDesign, and Adobe Illustrator.
